



## **CULTURAL DIVERSITY & INDIGENOUS COMMUNITIES RESIDENCY**

### **DESCRIPTION OF THE GRANT**

This grant offers a 5-month artistic residency (from February 23 to July 21, 2018) to an artist from Global or Indigenous communities of the city of Montreal or the island of Montreal to carry out a project at AC. This residency will offer the selected artist access to a professional print studio, allowing them to develop and create an artistic project with technical assistance.

- What the residency offers to the artist:
- A consecutive 5 month work plan (value of \$ 800);
- A \$ 2,000 honorarium;
- 25 hours of coaching / training / printing (value of \$ 1000);
- A \$ 350 credit at the AC's Art Supply Store;
- Free technical support during the "Fridays at the Studio" activity;
- A presentation and exhibition of the work at the Members' Gallery (in the production studio);
- Promotion of the work by our communication team;

### **HOW TO PARTICIPATE ?**

All candidates must be:

- A professional artist or in the process of becoming a professional artist;
- A citizen or permanent resident of Canada;
- From an Indigenous community and domiciled on the territory of the agglomeration of Montreal or the island of Montreal (see the CAM definition);



Or

- From an ethnocultural community (1st generation) and domiciled on the territory of the island of Montreal

### **CONTENT OF THE APPLICATION FILE**

- An identity card with photograph and residence address (health insurance, driver's license or passport);
- A proof of residence (electricity, gas, telephone bills, etc.), if applicable;
- An artist's resume and a short biography;
- A short text describing the general artistic approach of the artist;
- A general and technical description of the project to be carried out;
- 5 to 15 images of works (JPEG format, RGB, approximately 1024 x 768 pixels) (if necessary, video or audio documentation can be sent via Vimeo, Youtube or Soundcloud links);
- A descriptive list of the images indicating the title, the year, the medium and the dimensions of the works.
